



This October sport fishermen will have the opportunity to compete for \$1.5 million peso in guaranteed cash prizes and a brand new Ford Lobo. The La Paz Gold Cup Black & Blue Marlin Tournament is the competitive sport fishermen's opportunity to challenge famous fishing grounds and support a non-profit organization at the same time.



Rotary International is an international organization that integrates business and professional leaders with the humanitarian needs of the community. The Rotary promotes high ethical standards in all vocations and helps to build peace and goodwill world wide. There are approximately 1.2 million Rotarians worldwide with more than 32,000 clubs in more than 200 countries.

Rotary Club La Paz Balandra was founded in July of 1988 and for the last two years has been dedicated to the development of a clinic that specializes in the design, manufacture and installation of prostheses. The Clinic has help to rehabilitate over 50 adults and children in Southern Baja. With the help of the Rotarians in coordination with the organization "Mobilizing for Humanity" they are providing the resources to improve lives. Professional specialists have generously donated their time to this worth while cause.

In order to generate the resources for this effort the Balandra Club holds two annual sport fishing events in La Paz, Baja California Sur. This years first annual La Paz Gold Cup will be held beginning October 4, 2007 and run through the final awards banquet hosted by CostaBaja Resort & Marina. First prize for the event will net the winner \$1,000,000 pesos (about \$91,000USD) and if the winning fish is over 400lbs he or she will drive away in a brand new Ford Lobo.

Entry fees are \$5000 pesos per vessel with up to 4 anglers and \$1000 pesos per angler there after.
