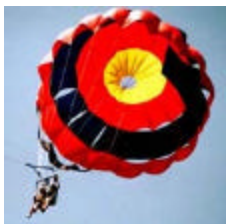

These six hour excursions in comfortable, air conditioned vans can take you to La Paz or Todos Santos.
